1. My name is Terry Jones. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") as Vice President, Nuclear Power Uprate. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. I have reviewed Exhibit C and the documents that are included in FPL's Request for Confidential Classification of information contained in FPSC audit staff's report titled Review of Florida Power & Light Company's Project Management Internal Controls for Nuclear Plant Uprate and Construction Projects, dated June 2013, for which I am identified on Exhibit C as the affiant. The documents and materials that I have reviewed contain proprietary confidential business information, including information concerning bids or contractual data and information related to competitive interests. Disclosure of this information would violate FPL's contracts with its vendors, work to the detriment of FPL's competitive interests, impair the competitive interests of its vendors and/or impair FPL's efforts to enter into contracts on commercially favorable terms. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of these documents and materials.


