MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S RESPONSES TO STAFF'S SECOND DATA REQUEST

Staff 1: Please refer to Joint Petition, Exhibit A, Page 9 of 15, Article IX.

<u>Staff 1a.</u>: Is MDWASD authorized per the joint petition to use its landfill gas to operate its lime kilns at its Alexander Orr and Hialeah plants from 2014-2023?

<u>Miami-Dade Response</u>: No. Also, please note that since the Natural Gas Transportation Service Agreement ("TSA") does not apply to the Blackpoint plant, the parties have agreed to remove the last sentence in Article IX of the TSA which reads: "However, nothing herein shall prohibit Customer from extracting and consuming landfill gas at Customer's facilities."
