CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Now we're moving to Item Number 2.

MS. COWDERY: Good morning, Commissioners. My name is Kathryn Cowdery with the Office of General Counsel.

Item 2 is the proposed repeal of Rule 25-17.006, *Florida Administrative Code*, electric utility system conservation end use data. This rule requires certain utilities to submit information to the Commission which is used in establishing energy conservation goals. The rule has become unnecessary because the information it requires is duplicative of information available from other sources.

Staff is available to answer any questioning.

CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Okay. Thank you very much.

Commissioners, are there any questions on this item? Commissioner Balbis.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I don't have any questions on this item, but I just wanted to commend staff on bringing forth this rule amendment to our attention. I think that any

1 time that we can eliminate duplicative rules,
2 information, or any other work, I really appreciate it.
3 So I want to thank staff for bringing this for us -- to
4 us. And I know we are going to be, begin the goal
5 setting process soon, so I look forward to reviewing
6 this type of information in that docket.

9 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Thank you. I was
10 just going to kind of follow up on that to say that
11 my understanding is that this rule at this time, not
12 when it was adopted but as time has gone on, has
13 become somewhat unnecessarily redundant, and so
14 there is no -- by repealing this rule there is no
15 harm to the public or to the access of information.
16 And I also appreciate staff for continuing to review
17 our rules to help us stay current and efficient, and
18 I would move the staff recommendation.

19 **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Thank you. It's been
20 moved. Is there a second?

21 **COMMISSIONER GRAHAM:** Second.

22 **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Any further comments or
23 questions? All right. Seeing none, all in favor,
