2           **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Moving on to Item Number  
3 5.

4           **MR. GARL:** Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

5           Item 5 is a petition from Florida City Gas  
6 requesting approval of tariff modifications for  
7 natural gas vehicles. The company proposes three  
8 methods of providing fueling of NGVs. In the first  
9 method, City Gas would provide fueling facilities on  
10 the customers' premises. Second would be limited  
11 access facilities on City Gas property. And the  
12 third method would be publicly accessible fueling  
13 facilities on City Gas premises.

14           Staff analysis has shown the proposal is  
15 reasonable, cost-based, and will allow City Gas to  
16 recover its costs of providing NGV service.

17           Staff recommends approval.

18           **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** All right. Thank you  
19 very much.

20           Commissioners, any -- okay, Commissioner  
21 Balbis.

22           **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Thank you. I have a  
23 quick question for the company.

24           Of those three options, which one do you  
25 think would be more attractive or most attractive to

1 customers? Do you have any feeling about that, or  
2 are you just going to propose these three options  
3 and see what the market dictates?

4 **MR. SULMONETTI:** This is Brian Sulmonetti  
5 with Florida City Gas. We are not exactly sure, but  
6 probably the first option, you know, people wanting  
7 to put compressors and so forth on their property in  
8 the beginning. And hopefully we can get to limited  
9 access. You know, it's kind of a train of events  
10 there.

11 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Okay. Thank you.

12 And I would make similar comments,  
13 thanking the company for moving forward with these  
14 changes, and hopefully it will encourage companies  
15 to make the switch, so --

16 **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** All right. Thank you  
17 very much. Any further comments or questions?

18 Okay. Seeing none, I think now it's  
19 appropriate for a motion.

20 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Mr. Chairman, I move  
21 approval of staff's recommendation on all issues.

22 **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Okay. Is there a second?

23 **COMMISSIONER GRAHAM:** Second.

24 **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Okay. It has been moved  
25 and seconded.


