**Docket No. 120290-WU** – Request for approval of amendment to tariff sheets for miscellaneous service charges in Polk County by Pinecrest Utilities, LLC.

**Issue 1:** Should the Commission approve Pinecrest's request for approval to amend its tariff sheet for miscellaneous service charges to include a convenience fee for customers who opt to pay their water bill by debit or credit card via telephone?

**Recommendation:** Yes. Pinecrest's request for approval to amend its tariff sheet for miscellaneous service charges to include a convenience fee of \$2.50 for customers who opt to pay their water bill by debit or credit card via telephone should be approved. The charge should be effective for services rendered on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475, Florida Administrative Code. (F.A.C.) The revised tariff sheet should become effective on or after the stamped approval date on the revised tariff sheets, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475, F.A.C. If a protest is filed within 21 days of the issuance date of the Order, the tariff should remain in effect with the charge held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest.
