**FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Request for Confidential Classification of certain information provided in its Responses to Staff's First Data Request Nos. 3 and 6 in this proceeding. In support of this Request, FPL states:

1. On September 3, 2013, FPL filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of the attachments to FPL's responses to Staff's First Data Request Nos. 3 and 6. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, FPL has 21 days from the date of the Notice of Intent to file a formal request for confidential classification. Accordingly, FPL is filing this Request for Confidential Classification to maintain continued confidential handling of the information contained in the attachments provided to Staff with the Notice of Intent.

2. The following exhibits are included with this request:

(a) Exhibit A is an unredacted copy of the documents for which FPL seeks confidential treatment. Exhibit A is being submitted separately in a sealed envelope labeled "CONFIDENTIAL." In the unredacted version, the information asserted to be confidential is highlighted in yellow;

(b) Exhibit B contains two copies of a redacted version of the documents for which FPL requests confidential classification. The specific information for which confidential treatment is requested has been redacted;

(c) Exhibit C is a table that identifies the information for which FPL seeks confidential classification and the specific statutory bases for seeking confidential treatment; and

(d) Exhibit D consists of the affidavit of Rosemary Morley.

3. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3). This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

4. As the affidavit included as Exhibit D indicates, the confidential information contained in the Responses to Staff's First Data Request Nos. 3 and 6 consists of proprietary forecast data provided pursuant to FPL's contract with a third party vendor that expressly prohibits FPL from disclosing the subject data. Thus, disclosure of this information would impair FPL's efforts to contract for these goods and services on favorable terms in the future. In addition, disclosure would harm the vendor's competitive interests. Such information also is protected by Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e).

5. The information for which FPL seeks confidential treatment is intended to be and is treated as confidential by FPL. The information has not been disclosed to the public.


6. FPL requests that the information identified above be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of section 366.093(3), F.S., that the information remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in section

366.093(4), F.S., and that the information be returned as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that this Request for Confidential Classification be granted.


BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Rosemary Morley who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

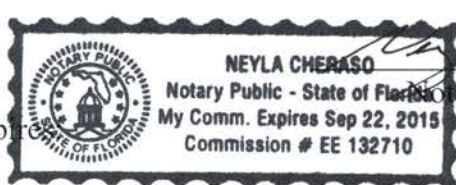
