**AT&T FLORIDA’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF DURATION OF
ORDER NOS. PSC-12-0213-CFO-TP, PSC-12-0214-CFO-TP, PSC-12-0215-CFO-TP,
AND PSC-12-0216-CFO-TP GRANTING CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (“AT&T Florida”), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files its Motion for Extension of Duration of Order Nos. PSC-12-0213-CFO-TP, PSC-12-0214-CFO-TP, and PSC-12-0215-CFO-TP, and PSC-12-0215-CFO-TP Granting Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

1. On April 23, 2012, the Florida Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) issued Orders granting AT&T Florida’s Request for Specified Confidential Classification of Document Nos. 01297-12 (x-ref Document No. 00842-12), 01867-12 (x-ref Document No. 02296-12), 00998-12, and 01319-12 (x-ref Document No. 00863-12).
2. The reasons AT&T Florida asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original Requests for Specified Confidential Classification remain. Specifically, there remains a need to protect proprietary business information, customer information and competitive interests which is not subject to public disclosure.
3. On July 30, 2012, the Commission issued Order No. PSC-12-0390-FOF-TP finding that Express Phone was not eligible to adopt an alternative interconnection agreement

based on the record in the instant proceeding. Certain of the confidential information subject to this request are part of record. In addition, Order No. PSC-12-0390-FOF-TL is subject to a pending appeal in the Northern District of Florida.

4. The information requested remains in the possession of the Commission Staff.

5. For the reasons set forth above, and in AT&T Florida's original Requests for Specified Confidential Classification, AT&T Florida hereby requests that the Commission enter an order extending the period of confidential classification for an additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of Staff.
