TRUSTEE'S VERIFIED MOTION FOR SUBSTANTIVE CONSOLIDATION

COMES NOW the Trustee, by and through his undersigned attorneys and hereby files this Verified Motion for Substantive Consolidation of the above-referenced four bankruptcy cases and in support thereof, states as follows:

- 1. The four (4) above-referenced Bankruptcy Cases were filed on May 1, 2011.
- The four (4) Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Cases were converted to Chapter 7 on February 2, 2012.
- 3. Richard B. Webber, II was appointed the Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Trustee in all four (4)

cases.

- Trustee believes that it is necessary to combine the assets and the liabilities of these four
 related entities.
- Trustee believes that the payment of priority tax claims and the allocation of pro rata distribution percentage would much better be served by the consolidation of all the liabilities and all the assets currently under the Trustee's control.
- The Trustee believes that there is (1) a substantial identity between the identities to be consolidated; and (2) consolidation is necessary to avoid some harm and to realize some benefit.
- 7. The Trustee is currently in the process of negotiating a global settlement which would require a pro rata distribution to priority tax claims. The allocation of settlement funds to each estate would be problematic and the distribution accounting would best be served for all assets and all liabilities to be combined so that the pro rata distribution is the same.
- 8. The Trustee alleges in support of the Verified Motion for Substantive Consolidation; (1) the presence of consolidated financial statements; (2) the unity of interest in ownership between the various corporate entities; (3) the existence of a parent (Cordia Corp.) and intercompany loans; (4) the degree of difficulty in segregating and ascertaining individual assets and liabilities; (5) the existence of transfers of assets without formal observance of corporate formalities; (6) the comingling of assets and business functions; (7) the profitability of consolidation at a single physical location in one estate; (8) the parent owning the majority of the subsidiary stock; (9) the entities have common officers and directors; (10) the subsidiaries have been grossly undercapitalized; (11) the subsidiaries have transacted business with the parent and made upstream transfers which have never

been repaid; and (12) the entities have disregarded the legal requirements of separate

organizations. Attached hereto as Composite Exhibit "A" are charts of corporate

structure and charts of transfers which are incorporated by reference herein.

9. The Trustee believes that it is in the best interest of creditors in the four estates for

substantive consolidation and also believes that it will maximize an efficient distribution

to priority tax claimants.

10. As the Trustee has indicated to this Court from the very beginning, there will be no

distribution to unsecured creditors in these Bankruptcy Cases and the Trustee has worked

diligently to increase distributions to priority tax claimants.

LEGAL AUTHORITY

The Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals has ruled on substantive consolidation and is

controlling precedent in this Circuit. See Eastgroup Properties v. Southern Motel Assoc., Ltd.,

935 f. 2d 245 (1991).


