

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Florida Public Service Commission has received a petition from Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) in Docket No. 130225-EQ filed October 25, 2013, seeking a permanent waiver from Rule 25-6.065(6)(a), Florida Administrative Code. Rule 25-6.065(6)(a) addresses the location of the manual disconnect switch (MDS) of a customer-owned renewable generation system, specifically, that the MDS be mounted separate from, but adjacent to, the meter socket and readily accessible to the investor-owned utility.
