

Dear Sir or Madam:

Regarding Docket No: 130209, the application of North Peninsula Utilities Corp. to amend its Wastewater Utility Certificate No. 249-S to add territory in Volusia County, Florida; we object to this application because it does not give any indication of the environmental impact to the preserve located between Sunny Beach Drive and Island Cay Dr, west of the Sunny Beach condominiums. It is our understanding that this preserve contains the leach field for the Sunny Beach condominium septic system; therefore its current status will undoubtedly be impacted by the proposed change in the wastewater treatment for that development.

In addition to serving as a leach field, the preserve is also a nesting habitat for the Florida Gopher Tortoise, along with several other indigenous species. In Florida, the gopher tortoise is listed as threatened. Both the tortoise and its burrow are protected under state law. Gopher tortoises share their burrows with more than 350 other species, and are therefore referred to as a keystone species. Any potential impact to this habitat should be carefully considered before any application for change is authorized.

We request that the commission withhold approval of this application until it is amended to include information on the anticipated change in zoning and use of the parcels of land that will no longer be used as leach fields within the boundaries stated in their application. We further request that approval be withheld until North Peninsula Utilities Corp has funded a thorough environmental impact analysis, conducted by an objective third party agency, of all the preserve areas that will be potentially affected by this application.






