STAFF'S SECOND DATA REQUEST

Re: Docket No. 130230-SU Application for amendment of territory for Certificate No. 300-S in Lee County by Forest Utilities, Inc.

Dear Mr. Wharton:

By this letter the Commission staff requests that Forest Utilities, Inc. provide responses to the following data requests:

1. According to the Settlement Agreement between Forest Utilities (Forest) and Jamaica Bay West, the rate Forest charges Jamaica Bay West shall not exceed Lee County's prevailing multi-family metered rates.

- a) What is the size of the master meter that serves Jamaica Bay West?
- b) What is the multi-family rate currently being billed to Jamaica Bay West by Lee County? How does it compare to the rate Jamaica Bay West would be billed by Forest?
- c) If Forest rates do exceed Lee County's rates, how will Forest treat the revenue deficiency attributed to a capped rate for Jamaica Bay West in a subsequent rate proceeding?
