Staff's Second Data Request

1. Please provide a three-year projected budget that includes rate base, cost of capital, and net operating income. Please provide all supporting documentation, including information regarding the assumptions and forecasts relied upon. Please provide all work papers associated with the creation of the budget.
2. Per the Bill of Sale, the total purchase price for the assets was \$10. Per the Application for Transfer (Exhibit D, Section 1.3: Consideration), the total purchase price paid was \$62,560. Per a review of the quit claim deed, a consideration paid of \$7,130 is shown. Please provide documentation explaining this discrepancy, as well as documentation of price paid including, but not limited to, a canceled check.
