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2 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Do you guys all get together
3 on Monday and practice this? (Laughter.) It flows very
4 well.

5 **MR. SPRINGER:** Good morning, Chairman and
6 Commissioners. I'm Michael Springer on behalf of
7 Commission staff.

8 Item 6 addresses S&L Utilities' prior
9 Commission-approved request to replace two air blowers
10 and the subsequent recovery of the cost with Phase III
11 rates.

12 The utility has indicated that the two
13 existing air blowers have been serviced and are
14 performing at their proper function. The utility filed
15 a letter on January 21st, 2014, indicating that it does
16 not intend to replace the air blowers at this time and
17 is requesting that the Phase III rates not be
18 implemented and the docket be closed. Staff is
19 available to answer your questions.

20 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Thank you, staff.

21 Any questions of staff? Seeing none, can I
22 get a motion?

23 Commissioner Balbis.

24 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

25 I just have one clarification, as I saw this

1 as a somewhat unusual docket. If the existing blowers
2 do fail and there is a discharge violation that results
3 in a consent order and/or fine, who would be liable for
4 that?

5 **MR. RIEGER:** Stan Rieger with staff. The
6 utility would be liable for that. The customers would
7 not be considered responsible for that.

8 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Okay. Thank you. And
9 with that, I move staff's recommendation on all issues.

10 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** It has been moved and
11 seconded, staff recommendation on all issues on Item
12 Number 6. Any further discussion?

13 Seeing none, all in favor say aye.

14 (Vote taken.)

15 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Any opposed?

16 By your action you have approved staff
17 recommendation on Item 6. Thank you, staff.

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
