On January 31, 2014, I informed you that pursuant to Section 4.5.2 of AT&T Florida's Self Effectuating Enforcement Mechanisms Administration Plan ("SEEM Plan"), AT&T Florida declared a force majeure event effective January 28, 2014 due to the late January 2014 ice storm.

I am pleased to inform you that as of January 31, 2014 AT&T Florida has lifted its force majeure declaration associated with Provisioning, Maintenance and Repair, and Trunk Group Performance in the designated wire centers.

Also, I can confirm that as of February 5, 2014, AT&T Florida has lifted its force majeure declaration associated with two Ordering measures¹ for all areas of Florida.
