It was a pleasure meeting with you again, thanks for taking the time. As per our conversation, we are pleased to provide you with our cost proposal for Caloosa Lake Village. The program is two phase with phase one being a surface mapping of the system (this assists locating manholes, etc. before mobilizing with the clean/televise equipment). Phase two includes high pressure jet cleaning of the pipelines and manholes then providing closed circuit television inspection of the pipe lines and manholes.
