Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light requests to extend the confidential classification of highlighted information in its MFR Schedules D-2 and F-4. Florida Power & Light's original Request for Confidential Classification of these items was filed on March 19, 2012 (01647-12), and by Order No. PSC-0424-CFO-EI, issued August 15, 2012, the Commission set forth an 18-month period of confidential classification. In its extension request, Florida Power & Light adopts and incorporates by reference the original request and Order No. PSC-0424-CFO-EI.

Staff has reviewed Florida Power & Light's extension of confidentiality request, and in staff's opinion, this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that FPL's First Request For Extension of Confidential Classification of Information in Florida Power & Light's MFR Schedules D-2 and F-4 00704-14 be approved.
