Rate Adjustment Factor by Florida Power & Light Company

On January 17, 2014, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) filed a petition for approval of a Generation Base Rate Adjustment (GBRA) factor of 4.566 percent for the Riviera Beach Energy Center (RBEC) to become effective on RBEC's commercial in-service date currently projected to be April 1, 2014. This petition was filed pursuant to the stipulation approved in Order No. PSC-13-0023-S-EI¹ (Order) that established the GBRA to allow the inclusion of three power plant modernization projects upon the commencement of each project's commercial service. The Order also grants staff the authority to approve the GBRA factors administratively.

The 4.566 percent GBRA factor will increase base rates by \$233,613,000 on an annual basis or \$2.40 per month for a residential customer using 1,000 kWh. However, this increase will be offset by a \$1.20 reduction in the fuel factor resulting in a monthly net increase of \$1.20 for a residential customer using 1,000 kWh.

Staff has reviewed the calculation of the 4.566 percent GBRA factor for the RBEC and recommends that it be approved.
