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## PROCEEDINGS

**MR. ELLIS:** Good morning, Commissioners. Phillip Ellis, Commission staff.

Item 8 is an application by Placid Lakes Utilities for amendment of its existing water certificate to include additional territory. During the utility's recent rate case, staff's review determined that the utility was serving approximately 55 water customers outside of its certificated service territory. At the time the utility mistakenly believed its territory included these customers and had included them in the calculation of its annual regulatory assessment fees. The utility, once made aware of the error, filed the petition before you to amend its territory to include these customers which it has been serving since the 1980s.

Staff recommends approval of the application and that the utility should be ordered to file revised tariffs reflecting the additional territory within 30 days. Staff is available for any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you.

Commissioners? Commissioner Edgar.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Just very briefly.

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Mr. Ellis, my understanding and my 1 recollection is that this action is consistent with the 2 brief discussion that we had when this utility was 3 recently before us; is that correct? 4 MR.
