
By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or utility) provide responses to the following data requests.

1. Please explain and provide the workpapers that demonstrate how the 30-year net present value of the estimated non-storm underground v. overhead operational costs differential of \$208 for the low density subdivision was calculated.
2. Please explain and provide the workpapers that demonstrate how the 30-year net present value of the estimated non-storm underground v. overhead operational costs differential of \$192 for the high density subdivision was calculated.
3. Referring to Appendix 4 URD, the document titled 2014 OH Density Layout with 3.5 Ton A/C, shows a MECA Stores LDG% for 2014 of 7.94%, please explain:
 - a. what "MECA" stands for;
 - b. how the MECA Stores LDG% was determined;
 - c. to what costs is the MECA Stores LDG% applied;
 - d. what is the difference between MECA and Actual Stores LDG?

4. Referring to Appendix 4 URD, the document titled 2014 OH Density Layout with 3.5 Ton A/C, shows an "Adjusted CO" for 2014 of 6.98%, please explain:
 - a. what "CO" stands for;
 - b. what costs are included in the Adjusted CO;
 - c. to what costs is the CO Stores LDG% applied?
