Request for Confidential Classification for Docket No. 01926-14

On April 24, 2014, Utilities, Inc. (UI or Utility) filed its request for confidential classification for Document No. 01926-14. The document is part of UI's response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories, Item No. 5(a), dated March 26, 2014. Certain information produced in response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories consists of employees' name and hourly rate from which an annual salary can be easily calculated. This Commission has recognized the confidentiality of salary information on numerous occasions. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with the Utility that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm UI's competitive business interests and would impair the ability of the Utility to contract for employees on favorable terms. Therefore, staff recommends that UI's request for confidential classification of Document No. 01926-14 be approved.
