# PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF TRUE UP AMOUNT FOR FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY

- Pursuant to the requirements in this docket, FPUC, concurrently with the filing of this

  2013.

As indicated in the testimony of Ms. Napier, FPUC's final true-up amount for the period January 2013 through December 2013, including interest, net of estimated true-up for the same period, is an over-recovery of \$95,276. This reflects the difference between the Company's actual over-recovery of \$2,826,059 for the period as compared to its estimated

over-recovery of \$2,730,783 for the same period, which was based on seven months actual and five months estimated data.<sup>1</sup>

WHEREFORE, FPUC respectfully requests that the Commission enter its Order approving the Company's final true up amount for the period January 2013 through December 2013.
