

Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. If Issue 1 is approved, the Settlement Agreement would resolve all matters in Docket No. 140031-WS in accordance with Section 120.57(4), F.S., and Order No. PSC-14-0131-SC-WS should become final. Staff recommends the docket remain open to process the settlement payments and to monitor ongoing compliance with the terms of this Settlement Agreement. Once all the terms of the Settlement Agreement and outstanding amounts owed have been satisfied, the docket may be administratively closed. Should Country Club fail to comply with any of the terms of the proposed Settlement Agreement, the Commission will seek to enforce the terms of the Settlement Agreement and pursue all reasonable means necessary to collect the amounts owed by Country Club, pursuant to Sections 120.69 and 367.121(1)(g) and (j), F.S., including, but not limited to, the placement of a lien on the real and personal property of Country Club.
