MS. CORBARI: Good morning, Commissioners.

Item 4A involves Docket 140031, initiation of show cause proceedings against Country Club Utilities for failing to remit its 2010, 2011, and 2012 Regulatory Assessment Fees.

Country Club has submitted a proposed settlement agreement to the Commission in order to resolve its apparent violations of the Regulatory Assessment Fee rule.

In particular, Country Club has offered to submit initial payment of \$19,517.21 to the Commission by May 14th to satisfy the principal balance of its delinquent 2010 and 2011 Regulatory Assessment Fees, after which Country Club will begin making monthly payments until the balance of all outstanding Regulatory Assessment Fees, penalty, and interest is satisfied. And Country Club is going to -- has agreed to withdraw its petition for a formal hearing within ten days -- of [sic] the Commission will approve this agreement.

Staff is recommending the Commission approve the proposed settlement agreement as it -- as staff believes the agreement is in the public interest and it

provides for the utility's future compliance with Florida Statutes, Commission rules, and promotes administrative efficiency, avoiding the time and expense of litigation. Staff is available to answer any questions.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Staff, I want to thank you guys for being diligent on this and working with the, the owner and coming forth with some sort of a settlement that makes sense.

Fellow Commissioners? Commissioner Edgar.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

Just very briefly. I concur. I think that settlement and the one that is before us does definitely seem to be in the public interest. I'm pleased that that is where we are in the process, but I also, I know this is a utility that has been before us more than once on similar issues, so I would just ask staff to stay on top of it, as I know you will. And I would move the item.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Second.
