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CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: The next one will be Item Number 5.

MS. KING: Good morning, Commissioners. Laura King with Commission staff.

Item 5 is a joint petition for approval of a second amendment to the territorial agreement between Tampa Electric and the City of Lakeland. territorial agreement was originally dated May 20th of 1991 and was first amendment -- amended in August 1998.

Recently the Petitioners have evaluated their entire boundary line to identify areas that needed adjustment based on existing facilities and load growth. This evaluation process identified four areas where such boundary changes were needed. No customers will be transferred if the second amendment is implemented, nor are there any facilities to be transferred and no purchase price will be involved. Staff believes the second amendment is in the public interest and will enable Tampa Electric and Lakeland to better serve their customers, and we recommend approval.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: If there are no questions, I agree with staff's recommendation and move 1

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CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Commissioner Balbis.
