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## PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Let the record show this is the Agenda Conference. It is Thursday, June the 5th. And we have a couple of things on the move staff list, so we'll be taking up Items 2, 3, 4, 6, and 8 first, and then we'll circle back around to take up 7 Items 1, 5, 9 through 15.

All right. That being said, let's start with Item Number 2.

MS. GERVASI: Good morning, Commissioners. Rosanne Gervasi with the Office of General Counsel.

Item 2 is staff's recommendation for the Commission to propose to amend Rules 25-30.455, 456, and 457, F.A.C., providing for staff assistance in rate setting for small water and wastewater utilities.

Section 367.0814, Florida Statutes, requires the Commission to adjust the gross annual revenue level for requesting and obtaining staff assistance on July 1 of 2013 and then every five years thereafter based on the most recent cumulative five years of the price index established by the Commission. This recommendation incorporates that adjustment into the rules, raising the gross annual revenue level from \$250,000 to \$275,000 for water or wastewater utilities, and then from 500,000 to 550,000 for water and

wastewater utilities on a combined basis.

We're also recommending the removal of certain language from the rules requiring what the Commission will consider in determining whether to grant or deny a request for staff assistance in order to afford the small water and wastewater utilities greater flexibility to receive staff assistance in rate proceedings.

Staff is available to answer questions.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, staff.

Commissioners. Commissioner Balbis.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

I just have a quick question for staff. In the recommendation you mentioned the statute that requires looking at the five-year, the five-year average, and that's what allowed us to raise the, the threshold level. And you mentioned in Attachment B that this results in three additional utilities being, being able to qualify for this.

Is there a way we can raise that amount so that perhaps other utilities can qualify and take advantage of that process, or is the statute that specific where our hands are tied?

MS. GERVASI: Commissioner, the statute is very specific about that, and it actually says that the gross annual revenue level shall be adjusted on July 1,

2013, and every five years thereafter based on the most 1 recent cumulative five years of the price index 2 established by the Commission. So I believe it would 3 take a legislative change in order to raise that 4 threshold to a higher level. 5 COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Thank you. 6 7 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commissioner Brown. COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. 8 9 Also I understand that no rule development workshop was held, but have you heard from any of the 10 stakeholders about this particular rule change? 11 MS. GERVASI: No, Commissioner, we have not. 12 13 We didn't receive any requests for a workshop or any comments from any interested person. 14 15 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Thank you. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Seeing no other questions or 16 17 comments, Commissioner Edgar. 18 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Move staff, Mr. Chairman. 19 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and 2.0 seconded, staff recommendation on Item Number 2. Any 21 further discussion? 22 Seeing none, all in favor, say aye. 23 (Vote taken.) Any opposed? By your action, you approved 24 25 staff recommendation on Item Number 2.
