Edward McDonald seeks relief from the Public Service Commission's December 31, 2012, order denying his motion for reconsideration, motion to stay proceedings, and motion to strike. 

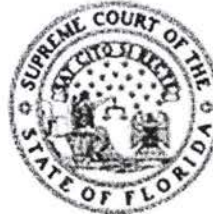
