Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) requests confidential classification of its Responses to OPC's Fourth Request for Production of Documents No. 87A, 87B and 87C, and OPC's Fifth Request for Production of Documents No. 93A, 93B and 93C, on CD in its entirety, in Docket No. 140025-EI, Petition for Rate Increase by Florida Public Utilities Company, Document No. 03685-14.

Staff has reviewed FPUC's Request for Confidential Classification and believes the requested information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(b), (d) and (e), F.S.
