Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) requests confidential classification of portions of the Rebuttal testimony of Cheryl M. Martin, Exhibit CMM-10 in its entirety; and Matthew Kim, p. 11, lines 7-8, p. 12, lines 11-21, p. 13 lines, 1-4, p. 32 lines, 12-14, p. 33, lines 13-15, p. 34, lines 11-13 and Exhibit MK-2, pp. 1-22, in Docket No. 140025-EI, Petition for Rate Increase by Florida Public Utilities Company, Document No. 04234-14.

Staff has reviewed FPUC's Request for Confidential Classification and believes the requested information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(b) and (e), F.S.
