The purpose of this this meeting is for the Commission to discuss Duke Energy Florida's rerouting initiative with the Company's management. In particular, the Commission plans to discuss the necessity and scope of the rerouting initiative; specific information regarding bill impacts for the rerouting initiative; possible resolutions, if any, to address customers' concerns regarding being billed for an extended billing period at the higher tiered charges; and any other topics the Commission may determine to be relevant to Duke Energy Florida, Inc.'s rerouting initiative. One or more of the Commissioners of the Florida Public Service Commission may attend and participate in the meeting.
