
Response to email, 8/29/14

RE: Bulk Water from CCU and LG1 Water Distribution System Extension

This Proposal/Agreement is between <u>Little Gasparilla Island Water Utility/Lick Bover and DMK Associates, Inc. of 435 Commercial Court. State 200</u>, Venice, bl. 34292. The Description of the land on which these services will be performed in Little Gasparilla Island and the ICW.

DMK Associates (DMK) shall provide engineering, survey and permitting services required to construct a 6-inch potable water/fire service line from a CCU supplied water meter near Cape Haze, directionally bored under the ICW to connect with existing LGI facilities on Little Gasparilla Island. DMK's design and permitting efforts will include the demolition and replacement of the R/O plant's deteriorating wood, pump house building and the extension of their water distribution system to the north end of Little Gasparilla Island.

DMK secretices shall include, but likely not be limited to:

Task 1 Engineering Services

During the Engineering phase, DMK shall provide:

- a. Drafting services for the demolition and reconstruction of the wood pump house building at the LGI water plant from a sketch provided by the Client.
- b. Engineering and design services for a 3,300 linear feet of a directionally bored 6-inch water main under the ICW from Cape Haze to LGI to connect existing CCU and LGI water facilities
- c. Engineering and design services for 1,800 linear feet of a 4-inch extension to the existing water distribution system to the north end of Little Gaspavilla Island.

Task 2 - Permitting Services

DMK shall combine the pump house replacement, directional bore under the ICW and the water distribution extension into an Environmental Resource and Water Main Extension Permit submittal to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. Our permit submittal will be compliant with Rule 62-555,330, F.A.C. The Army Corp of Engineers and FDEP's Bureau of Beach and Coastal Systems will also be involved in the FDEP permitting process.

Task 3 - Sovereign Submerged Land Lease

Once FDEP conceptually approves the directional bore alignment under the ICW, DMK shall prepare a Land Lease Easement across Gasparilla Sound, from approximately Lot I, Block U, Cape Haze subdivision on Green Dolphin Drive to King Street on Little Gasparilla Island. The proposed route will cross privately owned submerged lands by Cape Haze Corporation and West Coast Inland Navigation District which may require separate easements for each, not included in this proposal.

Budget for Remaining Engineering Services

Jack,

We have billed on our agreement for three different tasks.

<u>Task 1</u> was developed to prepare a schematic layout of the wood frame structure over the water tank. This task was combined with the initial pipeline design including the directional bore and 4 inch northern line extension. We are done with the building layout as this did not include any structural work. We are almost done with the pipeline design. Total fees for this task are at approximately \$13,800 out of budgeted \$18,000. We would like to keep the remaining \$4,200 in reserve for any further changes in the permit application.

<u>Task 2</u> pertains to the permitting where we had a budget of \$20,000. We have spent the budget as of today, and are expecting a water main and ERP permit within days. There is a risk that an additional Request for Information may come instead. If we get the water main permit and the ERP requires additional work we may have to go over budget by as much as \$5,000. We would instead place these fees into <u>Task 1.</u>

<u>Task 3</u> pertains to the land lease where we raised the budget from \$4,500 to \$10,000. You signed off on this change. At this time we are at \$9,500 in billing on this task. I think we are doing fine here.

<u>Task 4</u> was set aside for additional services. Nothing was budgeted here and we have not invoiced anything under this task. We are asking to place money in reserve here for budgetary reasons explained below.

We would like to establish <u>Task 5</u> for land surveying related to construction staking and easement preparation and <u>Task 6</u> for engineering services during construction and final certifications.

<u>Task 5</u>, Land Surveying and Easement Preparation should now be based upon staking and verifying the pipe route. You should budget \$8,000 for this. Contractor will provide staking for subaqueous line along with necessary asbuilts, boring locations, etc. This task is for upland line staking and as builts. An additional \$10,000 ios budgeted for up to 36 combined construction

and permanent easements. This Task should be budgeted for \$18,000 none of which has been billed to date.

<u>Task 6</u>, Engineering Services During Construction. You should budget 3 months at \$4,000 per month for inspection and services during construction and an additional final certification package at \$4,000 upon completion.. All are hourly budgets. This would bring this task budget to \$16,000

All things considered, the total budget for this project would then sit at:

•	Task 1	\$18,000. We have money to work with here
•	Task 2	\$20,000. This money is spent
•	Task 3	\$10,000. This money is spent
•	Task 4.	\$8,000. We have roughly calculated this at 10% of our total estimate for budget reasons. This task normally occurs at the bottom as contingency.
٠	Task 5.	\$18,000. Land Surveying and Easement Preparation. No money has been spent to date
•	Task 6.	\$16,000. Engineering Services During Construction.

Total Engineering Fees, should be overall budgeted for \$82,000 plus 10% for Task 4 services for a total of \$90,000. You should subtract what has been billed from this number for a remaining budget.

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
