On August 19, 2014, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 04588-14. The submission contains information provided in the direct testimony of witness Napier at pages 4 and 5, addressing FPUC's PGA Actual/Estimated Projections. In the document materials, the information for which FPUC seeks confidential treatment relates to information concerning bids or other contractual data and information relating to competitive interests. Staff has reviewed the documents and concurs with FPUC that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the efforts of the utility to contract for goods or services on favorable terms and would harm utility customers' competitive business operations.

Therefore, staff recommends that FPUC's request for confidential classification of Document No. 04588-14 be approved.
