The following are Little Gasparilla Water Utility, Inc.'s ("LGWU") responses to several informal request from the PSC Staff.

LGWU has received request for water service from approximately ten customers in the northern portion of its service area, which is the basis for the construction of a water main to those customers, and eventually the other customers who may be in proximity to that main. LGWU only has one remaining easement to obtain and it is forthcoming.

The service availability charges contained in the agreement with Charlotte County Utilities are correct. They differ from Ordinances in that LGWU is the only customer to whom bulk water is sold in this manner and the service availability charges were developed especially for LGWU.

The loan does not include the cost of construction of the office building.
