Commissioners, Item 2 addresses the selection of a new relay provider and the appointment of a new member to the TASA Advisory Committee.

In Issue 1, staff recommends the selection of Sprint as the relay service provider beginning service on June 1st, 2015.

In Issue 2, staff recommends the appointment of Mr. Rick Kottler to the TASA Advisory Committee.

Mr. Kottler previously served on the TASA Advisory

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Committee in the past.

As you are aware, at the June 5th, 2014, agenda the Commission issued an RFP, a request for a proposal, specifically describing the relay service to be provided. The Commission received two proposals, one from Hamilton Relay and one from Sprint. Staff's recommendation to select Sprint is based on evaluation results and calculations that staff did as a part of a formal evaluation process. We're prepared to answer questions at this time.

Thank you, staff. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: questions of staff? Imagine that. Commissioner Brown. (Laughter.)

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Just imagine.

Well, first, I do want to congratulate Sprint for their being selected to provide the relay services for the next three years. And really I'd like to thank our staff in person, specifically Mr. Curtis --Mr. Williams for working so diligently and independently on coming to this selection. It really showcased two competitive, competent bidders. And I want to commend Hamilton as well for their participation in this bidding process, and I appreciate their continued interest also in providing relay services here in Florida. And I wanted to let them know that they certainly were

competitive along this process. And thanks also to 1 Sprint for providing that attractive proposal. 2 With that, I do have a question for staff or 3 legal, Ms. Page, regarding the elements that will 4 comprise the actual contract and what we are approving 5 here today. 6 7 MS. PAGE: According to the RFP, the contract will consist of the RFP and Sprint's response to the 8 9 RFP. 10 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Is there any other elements including -- I know last time we had a letter 11 that went to AT&T that had additional terms. Will that 12 13 also be produced? 14 MS. PAGE: No, Commissioner, but we will have a contract agreement which both parties will sign, and 15 16 that will be part of the contract document. 17 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Mr. Chairman, with 18 that, I would move staff recommendation on Issues 1, 2, 19 and 3.CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and 20 21 seconded, staff recommendations on Item Number 2, Issues 22 1, 2, and 3.
