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2 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** We're going to skip over and
3 come back to Item Number 7.

4 Item Number 8.

5 **MR. GRAVES:** Good morning, Commissioners.
6 Robert Graves from staff.

7 Item 8 is staff's recommendation to suspend
8 the final requested rates of Sanlando Utilities
9 Corporation and to approve an interim increase subject
10 to refund with interest. Staff is recommending an
11 interim rate increase of 2.48 percent for water and no
12 increase for wastewater. Staff is available to respond
13 to questions that you may have.

14 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Commissioners, any questions
15 of staff on item number 8?

16 Commissioner Brown.

17 **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** I'm sorry. I have a
18 question.

19 Mr. Graves, I just want to question for
20 clarify. We just received the July through September
21 administrative disposition of certain matters report,
22 and it had the 2009 rate case, the Sanlando rate case.
23 The expiration of that would occur in August '24. So
24 what effect would that have on the working capital here
25 during the interim test year in this recommendation?

1 **MR. BUYS:** Yes, Commissioner. Dale Buys with
2 staff. Once the -- I believe you're talking about the
3 rate case expense that's included in the working
4 capital?

5 **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Yes.

6 **MR. BUYS:** Once the four years amortization is
7 completed from that prior rate case, that amount that's
8 included in working capital, which is one-half of the
9 allowed rate case expense from that rate case, will be
10 removed from the working capital amount in the rate
11 base.

12 **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** So does that mean that
13 that occurred, the expiration of that amortized rate
14 case expired in August of this year? Does that mean
15 that will be removed from this recommendation?

16 **MR. BUYS:** Not from the interim because that's
17 based on a 2013 test year.

18 **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Okay.

19 **MR. BUYS:** But going forward it will be
20 because that expires this year.

21 **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Okay. Thank you.

22 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Any other questions of staff
23 on Item Number 8? I'll entertain a motion.

24 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Move staff.

25 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** It's been moved and

1 seconded, staff recommendation on Item Number 8. All in
2 favor, say aye.

3 (Vote taken.)

4 Any opposed? By your action, you've approved
5 the staff rec. Thank you, staff.
