Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 06101-14

On October 29, 2014, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) and Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula) filed a joint request for confidential classification for Document No. 06101-14. This document contains responses from FPUC and Peninsula to staff's first data request. The information in the document for which FPUC and Peninsula seek confidential treatment relates to project construction costs and contractual terms such as the contracted capacity, annual reservation charge, rate per Dt of capacity, fuel retention percentage, and pipe parameters. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with FPUC and Peninsula that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information could impair both companies' ability to contract for goods and services, could impair Peninsula's competitive interests, and could result in harm, ultimately, to FPUC's ratepayers.

Therefore, staff recommends that the request by FPUC and Peninsula for confidential classification of Document No. 06101-14 be approved.
