<u>ESTABLISHMENT OF CREDIT</u> - Before rendering wastewater service, the Company may require an Applicant for service to satisfactorily establish credit, but such establishment of credit shall not relieve the Customer from complying with the Company's rules for prompt payment. Credit will be deemed so established if the Customer complies with the requirements of Rule 25-30.311, Florida Administrative Code.

<u>ADDITIONAL DEPOSIT</u> - Under Rule 25-30.311(7). Florida Administrative Code, the Company may require a new deposit, where previously waived or returned, or an additional deposit in order to secure payment of current bills provided.

<u>INTEREST ON DEPOSIT</u> - The Company shall pay interest on Customer deposits pursuant to Rule 25-30.311(4) and (4a). The Company will pay or credit accrued interest to the Customer's account during the month of January each year.

<u>REFUND OF DEPOSIT</u> - After a residential Customer has established a satisfactory payment record and has had continuous service for a period of 23 months, the Company shall refund the Customer's deposit provided the Customer has met the requirements of Rule 25-30.311(5), Florida Administrative Code. The Company may hold the deposit of a non-residential Customer after a continuous service period of 23 months and shall pay interest on the non-residential Customer's deposit pursuant to Rule 25-30.311(4) and (5), Florida Administrative Code.

Nothing in this rule shall prohibit the Company from refunding a Customer's deposit in less than 23 months.

MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGES

INITIAL CONNECTION CHARGE – This charge may be levied for service initiation at a location were service did not exist previously.

<u>NORMAL RECONNECTION CHARGE</u> – This charge may be levied for transfer of service to a new customer account at a previously served location or reconnection of service subsequent to a Customer requested disconnection.

<u>VIOLATION RECONNECTION CHARGE</u> – This charge may be levied prior to reconnection of an existing Customer after disconnection of service for cause according to Rule 25-30.320(2). Florida Administrative Code, including a delinquency in bill payment.

<u>PREMISES VISIT CHARGE (IN LIEU OF DISCONNECTION)</u> – This charge may be levied when a service representative visits a premises for the purpose of discontinuing service for nonpayment of a due and collectible bill and does not discontinue service because the Customer pays the service representative or otherwise make satisfactory arrangements to pay the bill.

<u>LATE PAYMENT CHARGE</u> – This charge may be levied for failure of a customer to render full payment of the bill within 20 days of the bill date, as set forth in Rule 25-30.335. The fee may be applied to any past due account on the 21st day after the bill date, once per billing cycle.
