
This is in response to the Final Order to the FPSC claims of the FPL smart meter fees.

The costs were already included in the base rates and under no circumstances could the company prove that the retention of the original analog meter caused an increase, particularly if one were able to provide an emailed snapshot of the meter reading, negating any necessity of a field visit. There has not been an outage in eight years in my area requiring service and charging on the basis of the speculation or probability of such an event is outrageous. It is not the job of FPSC to meet out inequality to the public so that some Floridians are being discriminated against for the benefit of others or unjust enrichment of FPL.

I believe the suggestion that FPL incurs any additional costs due to anyone's retention of an analog meter is specious and dishonest and has not and cannot be proven by them and therefore, should not be allowed.

Unfortunately we have seen a pattern across the states where all the Commissions are ruling similarly. It appears to be a coordinated and dishonest effort and the fact that members of PSC also sat on the FPL board shows bias and collusion. The increase should, therefore, be denied.
