Description:

This project is the construction phase of the previously approved engineering CP#2014043 project to replace the existing MCC panels that operate the Wekiva WWTF blowers, clarifier drives, exhaust fans and ancillary equipment. The project will include a VTS SCADA package with HMI interface to connect the WTP and Reuse PLCs to the main operations building via wireless connection.

Change Order #1 - For the provision or a redundant VPN access server with hardware and configuration. Install redundant secondary FIU (IP Gateway) with hardware and configuration.

Change Order #2 - The construction of new Brighthouse internet services as the primary communication path between SCADA and the Verizon Private Network.



JUSTIFICATION / ALTERNATIVES

Justification and Benefits:

The Wekiva WWTF MCC is dated and has outlived its usefull service life. Replacement parts are non-existant. The new MCC will provide many years of reliable service going forward. The new equipment will be relocated to the east side of the operations building to eliminate the extreme heat generated by the blowers where the equipment is currently situated along the south wall that abuts the blower room. The south wall of the operations building will be reconstructed using insulating materials to decrease the heat and decibel levels within the operations building and lower the AC/Heating costs going forward. The electrical upgrades will include a VTS SCADA package that will connect the WTP and Reuse building PLCs to a central monitoring station. The VTS contains alarm notification capabilities that will eliminate 4 out of the 5 C&A Alarm accounts but there will be an offset to that monthly expense reduction by having to add an additional separate phone line and dedicated modem with a static IP address.

Change Order #1 - The redundant VPN access server and FIU modules at Wekiva will provide full redundancy as back up for the LUSI SCADA system much like LUSI will be the redundant location for the Wekiva facility. This is critical in the event of an internet or modem failure at either of the two facilities that would otherwise prevent alarm signals from being dispatched. Change Order #2 - This increase is the construction costs associated with installation of internet service via hard wire to the Wekiva operations building. The cost to install an additional phone line was found to be cost prohibitive when compared to a Brighthouse connection. The internet connection will provide a communication path for the SCADA system and act independently from the corporate WAN.

Alternatives Considered:

Over the years the Utility has replaced various components within the existing MCC to maintain operational functionality. Locating repair parts has become increasingly difficult and now bordering impossible. In order to maintain operations and meet compliance, new equipment must be installed. The only alternative would be to eliminate the VTS SCADA package and operate as we have. The deduct for this portion of the work is approximately 12.5% of the project cost and considered marginal as compared to the benefits. The SCADA under this project is critically important in providing redundancy for our LUSI SCADA system as LUSI is in providing redundancy for the Wekiva plant.
