#### MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGES

<u>INITIAL CONNECTION CHARGE</u> – This charge may be levied for service initiation at a location were service did not exist previously.

NORMAL RECONNECTION CHARGE – This charge may be levied for transfer of service to a new customer account at a previously served location or reconnection of service subsequent to a Customer requested disconnection.

<u>VIOLATION RECONNECTION CHARGE</u> - This charge may be levied prior to reconnection of an existing Customer after disconnection of service for cause according to Rule 25-30.320(2). Florida Administrative Code, including a delinquency in bill payment.

PREMISES VISIT CHARGE (IN LIEU OF DISCONNECTION) — This charge may be levied when a service representative visits a premises for the purpose of discontinuing service for nonpayment of a due and collectible bill and does not discontinue service because the Customer pays the service representative or otherwise make satisfactory arrangements to pay the bill.

<u>LATE PAYMENT CHARGE</u> – This charge may be levied for failure of a customer to render full payment of the bill within 20 days of the bill date, as set forth in Rule 25-30.335. The fee may be applied to any past due account on the 21<sup>st</sup> day after the bill date, once per billing cycle.
