MS. HARLOW: Commissioners, Judy Harlow with Commission staff. Item 5 is --

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Judy, hold on just a second.

MS. HARLOW: Sorry. I jumped the gun.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: I appreciate your
enthusiasm.

(Laughter.)

Okay. Sorry about that.

MS. HARLOW: Thank you, sir. Commissioners,

I'm Judy Harlow with Commission staff.

Item 5 is staff's recommendation on the Associated Gas Distributors of Florida's request to extend the Conservation Demonstration and Development program for its seven-member investor-owned gas utilities. AGDF has not requested additional funding.

Staff is recommending approval of the extension with the modifications outlined in staff's recommendation. In particular, we have requested that you consider an annual cap on expenditures in order to mitigate potential rate impacts.

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Staff is available for any questions. We also have Ms. Beth Keating and Mr. Joseph Eysie of AGDF here to respond to your questions.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: You guys didn't have anything to add, did you?

MS. KEATING: Thank you, Mr. Chairman,

Commissioners. Again, Beth Keating with the Gunster

law firm here this morning for the AGDF. We're just

here in support of staff's recommendations, including

the modifications that they've proposed, and we're here

to answer any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, Ms. Keating.

Commissioner Brown.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: I seriously think it's this chair that just makes me more than chatty, and I apologize.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It is the chair.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: It's the chair. It's the chair. A tribute to Commissioner Balbis. So I'm in support of the extension of the CDD program. I'm just curious what the research findings and how they will be ultimately implemented, Ms. Keating or --

MR. EYSIE: Sure. And I think in reading staff's recommendation, it became abundantly clear that staff wants to see a direct tie to research to

conservation. And I think there's really two specific things that we can do moving forward.

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One, as we did with one of our two research projects, is to specify upfront what the deliverables are to be from the accredited research institutions that we partner with. Specifically we want to form CB1 through CB5 within the cost-effective test to be updated, which is ultimately what we need to create a conservation program. So the first thing is to specify on any research initiative that the specific types of deliverables will comply with the cost-effective test requirements stipulated by FEECA.

Secondly, instead of just sort of pursuing research initiatives, actually pursue them as pilot conservation programs. So we believe by doing those two specific things -- one, specifying what the deliverables are in conjunction with FEECA cost-effectiveness requirements and, number two, pursuing initiatives as pilot conservation programs -- we'll strengthen that tie between research and conservation.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Excellent. Great answer. Thank you. If you had to prioritize the 13 additional projects, you know, they vary a little bit,

do you have a priority list? You don't have to feel compelled to answer that.

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MR. EYSIE: Well, I mean, you're speaking to an energy nerd, so, I mean, I'm very interested in the emerging combined heat power types of initiatives. But really that's not a decision that I make. I execute from a project management perspective the decision from AGDF. So whatever they deem most prudent and has the highest connection and the strongest connection between conservation and research is what we'll pursue. But, I mean, there are some very interesting technologies out there that I believe do warrant research. But, again, that's not a decision that I would make.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Great. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any further questions or discussions from Commissioners? Can I hear a motion?

COMMISSIONER BROWN: So moved.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Second.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and seconded, staff recommendation on Item Number 5. Any further discussion? Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.

(Vote taken.)

Any opposed? By your action, you've approved staff recommendations on Item 5. Thank
