Per our telephone conversation, we would like to file staff's recommendation on this docket on February 19<sup>th</sup> for the March 3<sup>rd</sup> Agenda Conference. To do so, we need confirmation that provisions of the existing territorial agreement listed below have been completed.

1. Transfer of customer accounts
2. Transfer of customer deposits
3. Transfer of facilities
4. Payments, if any, for loss of revenue

We also need to know if you are aware of Duke and Suwannee requesting Commission approval of any interim service lasting a year or more, or of any previous changes to the agreement. (We have no record of either occurrence.)

In addition, we ask that you obtain agreement from Suwannee Valley on these points since a contact for Suwannee Valley was not included in the petition.
