Petitioner, Citizens of the State of Florida, through the Florida Office of Public Counsel, has filed a petition for a writ of prohibition, seeking to restrain the Florida Public Service Commission from conducting further proceedings on the petition currently pending before the Commission to establish guidelines for Florida Power & Light Company's participation in future gas reserves projects.

To the extent that the petition seeks a writ of prohibition to the Public Service Commission, the petition is dismissed.

To the extent that the petition seeks to invoke this Court's jurisdiction under the "all writs" provision of article V, section 3(b)(7) of the Florida Constitution, the petition is denied because Petitioner has failed to establish a basis for this Court to exercise its all writs jurisdiction.



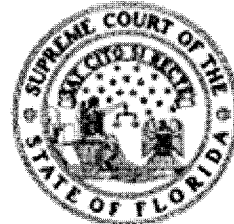
