**FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S FIFTH
REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF
INFORMATION PROVIDED IN FPL CONNECT SERVICE AUDIT (No. 05-285-4-1)**

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (2011) ("Section 366.093"), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code ("Rule 25-22.006"), Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain material provided to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Staff") pursuant to Audit Control No. 05-285-4-1 ("the Audit"). In support of its request, FPL states as follows:

1. On May 12, 2006, FPL filed its Amended Request for Confidential Classification of certain materials obtained during the Audit, which included Revised Exhibits A through E. On November 2, 2006, FPL filed an Amended Exhibit C to its May 12, 2006 Request. FPL adopts and incorporates by reference its May 12, 2006 Request and exhibits.

2. On May 16, 2008, FPL filed its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification of certain materials obtained during the Audit, which incorporated by reference the previously filed Exhibits A, B, and C and included First Revised Exhibit D. FPL adopts and incorporates by reference its May 16, 2008 Request and exhibits. By Order No. PSC-08-0515-CFO-EI, dated August 12, 2008 the Commission granted FPL's May 16, 2008 Request.

3. On March 15, 2010, FPL filed its Second Request for Extension of Confidential Classification, and on May 28, 2010 filed its Revised Second Request for Confidential Classification, which incorporated by reference the previously filed Exhibit A, Exhibit B and included First Revised Exhibit C and Second Revised Exhibit D. FPL adopts and incorporates

by reference its March 15, 2010 and May 28, 2010 Requests and exhibits. By Order No. PSC-10-0477-CFO-EI, dated July 28, 2010, the Commission granted FPL's March 15, 2010 and May 28, 2010 Requests.

4. On January 27, 2012, FPL filed its Third Request for Extension of Confidential Classification, FPL adopts and incorporates by reference its January 27, 2012 Request and exhibits. By Order No. PSC-12-0146-CFO-EI, dated March 28, 2012, the Commission granted FPL's January 27, 2012 Request.

5. On September 23, 2013, FPL filed its Fourth Request for Extension of Confidential Classification, which included First Revised Exhibit A, First Revised Exhibit B, Second Revised Exhibit C and Fourth Revised Exhibit D. FPL adopts and incorporates by reference its September 23, 2013 Request and exhibits. By Order No. PSC-13-0451-CFO-EI, dated October 8, 2013, the Commission granted FPL's September 23, 2013 Request.

6. The period of confidential treatment granted by Order No. PSC-13-0451-CFO-EI will soon expire. All of the information that was the subject of FPL's September 23, 2012 Request warrants continued treatment as proprietary and confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Accordingly, FPL hereby submits its Fifth Request for Extension of Confidential Classification.

7. Included herewith and made a part hereof is Fifth Revised Exhibit D, which consists of the affidavit of Maria Besada in support of this request. All of the information designated in First Revised Exhibit A, First Revised Exhibit B and Second Revised Exhibit C to the September 23, 2012 Request remains confidential. Accordingly, those exhibits are incorporated herein by referenced and will not be reproduced or reattached.

8. FPL submits that the information identified in the September 23, 2012 Request remains confidential continues to be proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Pursuant to section 366.093, such materials are entitled to confidential treatment and are exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

9. The information that FPL asserts is proprietary and confidential contains cost allocation models and transaction records for FPL Energy Services. The documents or materials contain or constitute trade secrets and information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which could impair the competitive business of FPL Energy Services, and with respect to certain information. This information is protected by Sections 366.093(3)(a) and (e), Florida Statutes.

10. Nothing has changed since the Commission entered Order No. PSC-13-0451-CFO-EI to render the Confidential information public, such that continued confidential treatment would not be appropriate.

11. FPL requests that this information be accorded continued confidential classification for an additional 18-month period. FPL further requests that the information be returned to FPL as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and affidavits included herewith, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
