

Dear Mr. Hein and Mr. Smallridge:

Pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-02-1168-PAA-WS<sup>1</sup> in Docket No. 010869-WS, East Marion was permitted to recover its rate case expenses over a four year period. The recovery period ended on September 4, 2006.<sup>2</sup> The Order specified that revised tariff sheets reflecting the elimination of this expense were to be filed with the Commission no later than one month prior to this date.<sup>3</sup> Schedule Nos. 4 and 4A of the Order set out the amounts by which the utility's rates were to be reduced.<sup>4</sup> While the rate reduction was recently implemented along with East Marion's 2014 index filing that became effective August 29, 2014, the delay in implementing the reduction resulted in East Marion overcollecting rate case expenses between September 2006 to September 2014.
