Docket No. 140176-WU – Application for approval of transfer of Certificate No. 116-W from Holiday Gardens Utilities, Inc. to Holiday Gardens Utilities, LLC, in Pasco County.

Issue 1: Should the application for transfer of Certificate No. 117-W from Crestridge Utility Corporation to Crestridge Utilities, LLC and Certificate No. 116-W from Holiday Gardens Utilities, Inc. to Holiday Gardens Utilities, LLC be approved?

Recommendation: No. Given the delays and failures to respond to staff data requests, providing conflicting and incorrect information, delays in paying filing fees, and delays in filing customer notices, the applicant has failed to meet his burden of proof that the proposed transfers are in the public interest. Therefore, the applications for transfer of Certificate No. 117-W from Crestridge Utility Corporation to Crestridge Utilities, LLC, and of Certificate No. 116-W from Holiday Gardens Utilities, Inc., to Holiday Gardens Utilities, LLC, should be denied.
