

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S
SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") supplements the Petition it filed on March 27, 2015 in the above docket as follows:

1. On March 27, 2015 Tampa Electric filed its Petition for Approval of Revised Net Metering Tariff and Agreement Adopting Terms of Standard Interconnection Agreement for Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 Renewable Generator Systems ("the Petition"). The Petition describes the company's need for a modification to its Net Metering Tariff (NM-1) and an associated new agreement that facilitates the adoption of the terms, conditions and obligations of an existing Standard Interconnection Agreement ("SIA") for Tier 1, Tier 2 or Tier 3 Renewal Generator Systems by tenants who lease premises with pre-existing customer owned renewable generator facilities installed by the property owner.

2. Following the filing of the Petition, the Commission's Staff issued Data Requests to the company which were responded to. The Staff subsequently noticed an informal meeting between Commission Staff and interested persons to this docket with the purpose of addressing Staff's concerns regarding matters proposed in the Petition. That meeting took place on May 21, 2015. During the meeting certain adjustments to the Agreement Adopting Standard Interconnection Agreement were discussed including identifying the specific provisions of the


pre-existing SIA the tenant would be responsible for as a Tampa Electric customer. Meeting participants also discussed possible language to clarify that the tenant's/customer's use and benefit of the renewable generation located at the premises could be impacted by the property owners' failure to abide by all of its commitments under the SIA between the property owner and Tampa Electric.

3. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a revised version of the Agreement Adopting Standard Interconnection Agreement marked in legislative format to reflect the changes discussed during the May 21, 2015 informal meeting. Tampa Electric believes these proposed modifications adequately cover the Staff's concerns addressed in the informal meeting and urge that they be approved. Attached as Exhibit "B" is a clean version of the Agreement Adopting Standard Interconnection Agreement including the changes reflected in Exhibit "A".

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric supplements its Petition in this proceeding and respectfully requests the Commission approve the Petition as supplemented by the modifications to the initial filing contained herein.



2-3. Customer acknowledges that Property Owner remains obligated to abide by all of its commitments under the SIA between Property Owner and Tampa Electric and that Property Owner's failure to do so may result in Customer's loss of the use and benefit of the renewable generation located at the Premises.

3-4. This Agreement shall remain in effect for the duration of Customer's rental and control of the Premises.
