CEDAR BAY GENERATING COMPANY'S THIRTEENTH REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Cedar Bay Generating Company, Limited Partnership ("Cedar Bay"), by and through undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes ("F.S."), hereby requests confidential classification for portions of the deposition transcripts and deposition exhibits ("Deposition Transcripts and Deposition Exhibits") of Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") witnesses Robert E. Barrett, Thomas L. Hartman, David W. Herr, and Kim Ousdahl ("FPL's Witnesses") which were filed with the Commission on July 13, 2015. In support of its request, Cedar Bay states as follows:

of Intent to Request Confidential Classification (the "Thirteenth Notice") (PSC Document #04389-15) related to FPL's Witnesses Deposition Transcripts and Exhibits (PSC Confidential Document #04390-15). Accordingly, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3) F.A.Z., this request is timely. Please note that Hartman Deposition Exhibit 5, Ousdahl Deposition Exhibits 2 and 3, Barrett

Deposition Exhibits 2 and 3, and Herr Deposition Exhibit 5 do not contain confidential material and Cedar Bay is hereby withdrawing its request for confidential treatment of these specific Deposition Exhibits.

- 2. The following exhibits are included and made a part of this request:
 - a. Exhibit A is a CD containing FPL's Witnesses'

 Deposition Transcripts and Exhibits on which all information for which FPL and/or Cedar Bay is requesting confidential treatment is highlighted.

 Please note that Cedar Bay is requesting confidential treatment for the indexes to FPL's Witnesses Deposition Transcripts in their entirety.¹ Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed envelope marked "CONFIDENTIAL."
 - b. Exhibit B consists of two CDs containing FPL's Witnesses' Deposition Transcripts and Exhibits on which all information for which FPL and/or Cedar Bay is seeking confidential treatment has been redacted.

See In re: Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Recovery Clause With Generating Performance Incentive Factor, Docket No. 150001-EI, Order Granting Florida Power & Light Company's Request for Confidential Classification (Document No. 06769-14), Order No. PSC-15-0132-CFO-EI (Pub. Serv. Comm'n, March 20, 2015) (granting request for confidential classification for entire word index to deposition transcript).

- c. Exhibit C is a table that identifies the specific statutory bases for the claims of confidentiality.
- d. Exhibit D contains the affidavits of Tom Hartman, Director of Business Development in FPL's Marketing and Trading Division; David Herr, Managing Director of Duff & Phelps, LLC; and Jacob A. Pollack, Vice President and Secretary of Cedar Bay.
- 3. Section 366.093(1), F.S., provides that "Upon request of the public utility or other person, any records received by the Commission which are shown to be proprietary confidential business information shall be kept confidential and shall be exempt from s. 119.07(1)." Section 366.093(3), F.S., defines proprietary confidential business information to mean information that is (i) intended to be and is treated as private confidential information by the company, (ii) because disclosure of the information would cause harm, (iii) to the company's business operation, and (iv) the information has not been voluntarily disclosed to the public. Additionally, section 366.093(3)(e) defines as proprietary confidential business information "information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

- 4. Cedar Bay is requesting confidential classification of portions of FPL's Witnesses' Deposition Transcripts and Exhibits (including the indexes to FPL's Witnesses' Deposition

 Transcripts) because FPL's Witnesses' Deposition Transcripts and Exhibits contain and Cedar Bay's proprietary, confidential, and competitively sensitive business information, including information concerning internal business plans, projected capital expenditures, confidential contractual negotiations, contractual arrangements, internal budget projections, financial forecasts, plant operations, internal finance structure, and other competitively sensitive commercial information, the disclosure of which would harm or otherwise adversely impact Cedar Bay's and/or Cedar Bay's affiliates' competitive business interests.
- 5. Additionally, FPL is requesting confidential classification of portions FPL's Witnesses' Deposition
 Transcripts and Exhibits because the designated materials constitute the proprietary business information of a third party related to the third party's competitive interests. The disclosure of this information would disadvantage FPL customers and would place FPL at a competitive disadvantage when coupled with other information that is publicly available. In particular, information designated as confidential consists of or relates to the two valuation reports of tangible and intangible assets performed by Duff & Phelps, Inc. The details of these highly

detailed valuation reports identify with specificity the proprietary methodology that a third party consultant, Duff & Phelps, employs in performing such valuations as well as certain commercial terms pursuant to which Duff & Phelps provides such valuations. Accordingly, public disclosure would impair the competitive businesses of Duff & Phelps. Other materials designated by FPL consist of negotiated terms between FPL and CBAS Holdings, LLC for the Cedar Bay transaction, the disclosure of which would impair FPL's ability or position to attain favorable transactions for the benefit of its customers in the future. Likewise, disclosure would impair CBAS Holdings, LLC's ability to negotiate terms with third parties indirectly affected by the Cedar Bay transaction. Additionally, the documents contain an analysis of FPL's economic options and strategies.

- 6. Cedar Bay and FPL have treated the information contained in FPL's Witnesses' Deposition Transcripts and Exhibits as confidential and Cedar Bay and FPL have not voluntarily disclosed the information contained in FPL's Witnesses' Deposition Transcripts and Exhibits to the public.
- 7. Upon a finding by the Commission that the material in Exhibit A for which Cedar Bay seeks confidential treatment is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S., such information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months.

Additionally, the material provided should be returned to FPL and Cedar Bay as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business, pursuant to Section 366.093(4), F.S.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and affidavits included herewith, Cedar Bay Generating Company, Limited Partnership respectfully requests that Cedar Bay's Thirteenth Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
