Issue 1: Should the Commission approve the Companies' joint petition for approval of a modified cost allocation methodology and revised PGA calculation?

Recommendation: Yes. The modified cost allocation methodology and resulting revisions to the PGA factor calculation would enable the Companies to have the ability to better balance the costs of individual projects across the entire Chesapeake Florida system, rather than on a system-by-system basis.





