Dear Chairman Graham,

On August  $18^{th} - 20^{th}$ , the Florida Public Service Commission is expected to hear Florida Power & Light's petition to recover Nuclear Cost Recovery dollars from ratepayers related to nuclear expansion at Turkey Point. As you know, FPL is requesting approximately \$34.2 million from ratepayers for 2016 related to Turkey Point expansion.

Because the nuclear expansion at Turkey Point will have an enormous impact on the lives of the residents of Miami-Dade County, Broward County, Monroe County, and Palm Beach County, which together make up a significant portion of FPL's customer base, I request that you hold the August  $18^{th} - 20^{th}$  Commission hearings in the City of Miami. FPL's NCRC case related to Turkey Point is likely to make up the greater part of the Commission's agenda and holding this hearing in the City of Miami will allow ratepayers in the region to face their commissioners and have input on an issue which will have a tremendous impact on their lives, much more so than by simply watching the hearing on a livestream.

There are several venues that could potentially be available should the Commission decide to hold the hearing in Miami. These include the Miami-Dade County auditorium, the Joseph Caleb auditorium, the Miami-Dade School Board auditorium, and many more. This request is in line with legislation filed during the 2015 regular legislative session requiring the Commission to hold meetings around the state, including SB 288 filed by Senator Latvala (requiring annual customer service meetings around the state).

Thank you for considering this proposal and working together to protect our residents in this important issue. I am happy to discuss this further at your convenience.
