2	MR. ROME: Item No. 20 is a joint petition by
3	four Florida gas utilities owned by parent company
4	Chesapeake Utilities Corporation to consolidate the
5	intrastate pipeline costs of the four utilities and
6	allocate those costs across all customers in the
7	purchased gas adjustment and transitional transportation
8	service pools. This would enable the companies to
9	better balance the costs of individual system projects
10	over the entire Chesapeake Florida system. Staff
11	recommends approval.
12	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commissioners, any questions
13	of staff on Item No. 20?
14	COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Move staff.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Second.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and seconded, staff recommendation on Item No. 20.

Yes, sir -- yes, ma'am, Commissioner Brown.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: I support the motion, but I'd like to ask staff a question briefly.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: I think this consolidated approach and phased-in approach makes sense to me for Chesapeake and FPUC. I'm just curious about the length of time that Phase 2 will occur and when the Commission

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can expect to see that come before us.

MR. ROME: From what we understand, the filing for the second phase potentially could come within the next six months approximately. And then at that time, from what we understand, there would be a delayed implementation date of perhaps as long as 18 months to allow the shippers to work with the customers with whom they have contracts to make any necessary adjustments that may need to be made at that time.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you so much. you.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any other questions of staff of Item No. 20? Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.
